BASIC SWAT COURSE

This fifty-hour course will present new tactical officers with the opportunity to be immersed in the complex roles and responsibilities associated with modern SWAT operations, centered upon mastery of the fundamentals. Our course heavily emphasizes practical repetitions in live range training, and in force-on-force simulations. Each component of this course is focused upon realism and repeatability.

Course curriculum will include modules on the following: basic operational planning and contingency preparations; tactical breaching; entry tactics and techniques; ballistic shield integrations; low/no light applications; critical incident responses; performance-based firearms training, and more.
